**Re: Plans for Year 10 from Monday 11th January**

Further to the letter we sent out on New Year's Eve, we hope you and your families remain well at this challenging time. I am sure many of you will have watched Boris Johnson's announcement yesterday evening, or have at least heard bits of it on social media. We were ready for this and whilst the closure of schools until mid February is not what any of us want for our young people, the staff at Logic are totally committed to providing an excellent quality of education and continuing to care for the wellbeing of young people.

Many of you will already have received a phone call from your child's Prep Tutor just to touch base and check you are all ok. Over the next few days, we will check in again and make sure you and your child know about the timetable for live lessons. The government has been very clear that all secondary students should receive a minimum of 4 hours work per day whilst they are not at school. We do not think it is good for young people to be glued to screens all day, so we have selected lessons where they will need to go online and others when they will have work set. There is a colour coded timetable attached to this letter and this is also available on the school website. Even when online, students will have periods of time working independently and should submit their work on Google Classroom as normal. We will be closely monitoring your child's engagement so we can support them as much as we can in this important year, and as well as a weekly phone call, we will also report to you in writing before half term.

- Students should come online and register with their Prep tutor at 9:30am. They will have a chance to speak with their teacher, ask any questions and check which lessons they have that day. We will call home for any students who haven't logged on so we can check everything is ok and that they are ready to log on for their lessons from 10am.
- Year 10 students will attend 3 - 5 live lessons throughout the day and a register will be taken in each one.
- Teachers will set work for the remaining lesson allocation (when they are not being delivered live).
- Students will have at least one knowledge test per week and will also get written feedback weekly.
- Students should also continue to use Tassomai for at least 10 minutes every day.

**What do we need you to do?**

2. Check the attached timetable and the times your child needs to be online or working offline each day.
3. Help ensure your child is up and ready to work at the right time each day.
