The Parent/s or Carer/s undertake to:

- ensure that their child attends school each day, is punctual, properly equipped and wears the school uniform correctly;
- ensure their child does not take any holidays during term time and try to avoid making appointments during the school day;
- support their child in all areas of the curriculum and help them achieve the best he/she is capable of;
- cover any absence with a letter or telephone call;
- attend all parent events and meetings about their child's progress;
- give full support to the school's policies including the Behaviour Policy, Uniform and Mobile Devices policies;
- attend all Safeguarding Events;
- notify the school about concerns that might affect their child's work or behaviour.





The Student undertakes to:

- bring the correct books and equipment to lessons;
- attend every day, on time and wear the school uniform correctly;
- keep him or herself safe, including use of the internet and social media;
- respect the school values and try his/her best to meet these.
- behave responsibly in school and on the journey to and from school at all times;
- treat all members of the school as he/she would wish to be treated;
- listen to others without interrupting and not to make remarks with the intent of hurting others;
- follow all instructions given by adults in school;
- complete and hand in all PREP on the date it is due;
- treat school property, including school technology, with care and treat their own and other people's property with respect.
