GCSE Revision Support for Year 11 Students this Half Term

Dear Parent / Carers,

After reviewing the result of the recent assessment students undertook in December, we are now in a position to launch our Year 11 Revision and Exam Support for this half term.

The aim of this is to help students fully prepare for their Summer GCSE exams and to ensure they are confident about what lies ahead over the coming months.

Over the next half term, the following will be taking place to support students:

- From **Monday January 12th**, targeted intervention sessions will be taking place for identified students across a range of subjects. These are by invite only and further information will be given to individual students directly to bring home this week.
- From **Monday January 12th**, we will also be launching a 'Study Enrichment Drop In' session at the end of each day in Room 10. This will be supervised by a member of staff and will allow students the opportunity to undertake individual revision in a calm and quiet environment.
- Our Year 11 Subject Evening for parents and students takes place on **Thursday January 22nd** from 4.30pm until 7pm. Your child has been given a letter to allow them to book an appointment slot. This is a really important evening and it is vital both you and your child are in attendance. This is to ensure you have a real understanding of what your child needs to do, in order to be successful this year. They will receive subject specific actions to support their success.
- Following the parents evening, we will be issuing students with individual Revision planners, which will include specific subject information and key strategies of how to revise. It will also contain the final exam dates for both the Mock Exams In February / March and the final GCSE exams this Summer.
- Our Year 11 Mock Exams will take place from **Friday 27th February and will run until Tuesday March 10th**. Further details will follow including specific exam dates and times, once these are finalised by the exams team. This will be the last opportunity for students to experience what the Summer exams will be like, giving them an opportunity to practice revision strategies and preparation; whilst also identifying areas in which they need to improve.
- Students will also be provided with a range of revision resources on their google revision classroom, which will include useful revision websites and past papers for each subject.

We are committed to ensuring every student has the tools and support they need to reach their full potential but to do this, we need your support! If you have any questions regarding the revision activities, please do not hesitate to contact me to discuss.
