RE: Post 18 Parents Information Evening

As your child approaches the final stages of Year 12, this is a crucial time to begin preparing for their post-18 pathway. We are therefore inviting all parents and carers to attend our **Post 18 Parents Information Evening on Thursday April 16th at 5.30pm.**

This session is designed to provide clarity, guidance and practical information about the options available to students after sixth form; and to outline the key milestones they will encounter as they transition into Year 13.

During the evening, we will discuss:

- A detailed overview of the **UCAS** application process including timelines, personal statements, predicted grades, references and key deadlines
- Guidance on researching and selecting appropriate university courses
- An explanation of **Degree Apprenticeships** and **Apprenticeships**, including how applications differ from university applications and what employers are looking for
- Important dates and expectations for Year 13
- The level of independence, organisation and commitment students will need to demonstrate in order to meet application deadlines and entry requirements

We will also explain how the school will support students throughout the process, including futures and employee engagement session guidance; one-to-one support; and key preparation activities during the remainder of Year 12.

This is an invaluable opportunity for you to gain a clear understanding of the systems and expectations involved, ask questions, and feel confident in how best to support your child during what is a significant and sometimes demanding year.

We strongly encourage all parents and carers to attend if possible, as informed parental support plays a vital role in student success at this stage.
