Subject: Warm Weather Update: Ensuring Comfort, Exams, and Continuous Learning at Logic

As the warm weather continues, I am writing to reassure you about the measures we have in place to keep our students cool, comfortable, and focused on their education during a highly critical week of the academic year.

We have noticed a drop in attendance today due to the heat. We strongly advise against keeping students at home; our school building is exceptionally well-equipped for these conditions and is likely cooler than many residential homes.

Our Heatwave Provisions Include:

- **Air-Conditioned Spaces:** A significant number of our classrooms are air-conditioned. Furthermore, our main Cyber Cafe is fully air-conditioned and open throughout break and lunch for students to relax in comfort.
- **Hydration & Refreshments:** Chilled water stations are fully active. Cold drinks and ice lollies are available for all students during break and lunch times.
- **Uniform Flexibility:** loose fitting t-shirt and shorts appropriate for the workplace are recommended (no football shirts).

Why Attendance Today is Critical:

- **Year 10:** Students are undertaking vital preparation for their **Maths mock exam tomorrow (Thursday)**, alongside indispensable administrative and safeguarding preparation for their upcoming **Work Experience**. Missing today and this week puts their placements and exam readiness at serious risk.
- **Year 12:** Key mock exams in **Business, Sociology, and Maths** are ongoing this week, running alongside vital, non-negotiable **coursework lessons** that cannot be replicated at home.

Attendance Expectations

Please note that school remains open and full attendance is a legal requirement. **Absences due to the hot weather will be recorded as unauthorised** unless medical evidence from a doctor or medical professional is provided directly to the attendance team.
